JNPA Races into World's Top 30 Container Ports

- JNPA jumps from 28th to 21st globally.
- Container throughput grew 13.6% in H1 2026.
- The port handled 4.4 million TEUs in the first half of 2026.
- JNPA recorded the fastest growth among the world's Top 30 container ports.



Mundra Port Container Movement Hit by Transporters' Strike

- Around 1,500 transporters have halted container movement.
- Strike follows APSEZ's move to shift empty-container handling inside Mundra SEZ.
- Exporters and importers may face delays in container pickup and delivery.
- Major shipping lines have issued advisories warning of operational disruptions

Port of Colombo Breaks into Global Top 20

- ▶ Colombo Port climbs from 26th to 20th globally.
- ▶ Container throughput rises 11.9% YoY to 4.44 million TEUs in H1 2026.
- ▶ 84.7% of its container traffic came from transshipment.
- ▶ Sri Lanka plans up to US\$2 billion in port and logistics investments.

- Record vessel-handling performance achieved.
- Strengthens Vizhinjam's role in global transshipment.
- Boosts India's maritime and logistics connectivity.
